SOME WOMEN NEED EXTRA SCREENING TESTS TO CATCH CANCER EARLY ...

1. DETECTING CANCER EARLY MAKES ALL THE DIFFERENCE

Women diagnosed with breast cancer at Stage 1 have nearly a 90% five-year survival rate, according to the American Cancer Society. However, women with Stage 4 cancers have only a 15% chance of living another five years. Finding breast cancer sooner translates to significantly higher odds of survival.

2. SOME WOMEN NEED MORE THAN A MAMMOGRAM

Mammograms are outstanding screening tools for many women. In women at high risk, however, mammograms can miss small cancers. If this happens, the cancer may go undetected until it grows much larger.
